

DIWO. DO IT WITH OTHERS, DO IT WITH OPERA


The DIWO Project is the name of the Erasmus+ project inspired by the successful educational project LÓVA (La Ópera, un Vehículo de Aprendizaje) that has been taking place in Spain for more than 13 years.

DIWO's main aim is to turn a classroom* into a company that creates, produces and performs its own original opera.

Students will work cooperatively to decide upon every step of the process, from the name and logo of the company, to the theme, the story, costumes, music, makeup, atrezzo... until the day of the Première.

Students and teachers will be using 2-3 sessions a week out of their academic time. During that period, they will play games, do different activities, learn about Opera, Music, Culture, and they will create their own show. The school will also plan a visit to a cultural/artistic Institution nearby, in order for students to get reccomendations and feedback on their work from opera professionals.

Students from the different countries involved in DIWO will share their experience through a blog on the eTwinning platform. They will record videos and take photos of the process, unabling us to design a short movie at the end of the DIWO Project showing what we did in each and every participating country.

DIWO TRAINING COURSE

JANUARY 2020 VALENCIA, SPAIN

Each partner will send 2 teachers participating in the project to complete the DIWO Training Course. A 40 hour intensive course about how to implement the project with the students.

The training was supposed to take place in Valencia in October 2020. Due to COVID-19 crisis the course has been postponed to the first quarter of 2021 (as long as the conditions are safe enough to do it).

For now, all teachers will start working online. We will arrange one videoconference per month to talk about the process, first steps to start implementing the project with the students, group activities, etc.



TRANSNATIONAL MEETINGS

Teachers involved in the project (any teacher working with the group of students) will also participate in 4 transnational meetings across Europe to talk about the project and check the process and results. (One meeting in each participating country: Portugal, Greece, Italy and Turkey) Schools don't always need to send the same teachers, but those travelling must at least know the project and be in touch with the students who create the Opera Company.
