





#### DIWO's TPM - Transnational Project Meetings

The project will give each partner the opportunity to act once as host country, being able to show first-hand how education is in their country, how they work in their schools, how they integrate arts and culture in the curriculum and open the doors of their classrooms to the rest of the DIWO team.

#### First Transnational Meeting. Portugal.

During this meeting, the group will be able to clarify doubts, ask questions, share how the DIWO process is going on, the positive aspects, the impact on the motivation of the students, the impact on the teachers, etc. At the same time, SCHOLÉ teachers will be able to show us first-hand how they work on a daily basis, with a methodological approach based on experimentation, project-based learning, design thinking... offering us a presentation on the techniques and strategies they use in their classrooms, inviting us to enter their classrooms to see and experience how students work independently, encouraging their creativity and responsibility in the learning process.

We think that their experience in this innovative methodology can be an excellent way to increase the energy of the teachers participating in the DIWO Project, as in the second phase of the project, students will have to make the most important decisions and prepare for their big day at the final premiere.

In addition, during this meeting we will address the tasks prior to the implementation of the final product with an emphasis on how to compile the videos and photographs of the process to make it a quality product.

#### **Practical Information**

#### <u>Getting there: Airport – Hotel – Airport</u>

The airport is located about 11 kilometres from the centre of Matosinhos city and 14 kilometres from the city centre of Porto. You can easily get to the airport or to the city centre by metro.

By metro, Line "E" (purple) alone, will take you to the centre of the city of Porto, it takes about 30 minutes. Each trip will cost you 2€. Line "E" (purple) runs every 20 or 30 minutes, depending on the time and day of the week.

If you wish to came to Matosinhos from the Airport, besides Line "E" (purple), you will also have to take the Line "A" (blue). It takes you about 40 minutes and the trip will cost you 1.60€.

Metro is the best option, but you can take a taxi or Uber from the Airport to your hotel, and the other way around. You can also check if your hotel has the option of transfer/shuttles from the Airport.

To use the Metro, we advise you to buy a regular ticket named "Andante" at any Metro station. This card is rechargeable and you can use it for your entire stay at our city. The cards can be recharged at any Metro station using the automatic machines available. It is mandatory to validate the card (using the machines available at all stations/buses) each and every time you enter a Metro or a bus.







#### <u>Getting there: Hotel – Scholé – Hotel</u>

Scholé is based in Matosinhos, at Rua do Godinho nº. 612-618. The school is located in Matosinhos city centre, just 700m from the seaside.

The venue place for our Transnational Project Meeting will be: Rua do Godinho № 656 4450-147 Matosinhos - PORTUGAL


Depending on the location of your hotel, you can either walk, take a taxi or travel by Metro to Matosinhos city centre (please find metro guidelines in the image below). The closest Metro Station to our school is "Brito Capelo" at line "A" (blue line).

Everything in the city centre, including the school, is walking distance.
